The Tomorrow Fund™

Established in 1995, United Way Toronto's endowment, The Tomorrow Fund™, chaired by Kathleen Taylor, gives people a unique opportunity to impact children's lives and the future health of Toronto. The Fund, which grew to \$51,405,000 in 2007, provides stable funding to Success By 6®, a United Way program, ensuring children six and under get the best start in life.

Success By 6® lays the foundation for early success in school by helping to improve family nutrition and parenting skills, and connecting isolated families to critical support systems.

Ready for School Connects is a school readiness program for newcomer families in the downtown area, funded by Success By 6®. Through a summer school readiness program for children and a series of parent workshops, the program addresses immediate barriers to settlement, and supports the development of the communication and social skills needed to transition the family into the Canadian school system.

United Way continues to reinvest a portion of The Tomorrow Fund's™ income without touching the principal. The Tomorrow Fund™ is here to stay and will continue to impact the lives of our community's children for generations to come.
