Minimum fundraising requirement is \$30.

To be eligible for the student rate, you must register for the Saturday Student Climb, be under the age of 25 and present a valid student card upon wristband and timing chip pick up.

All climbers must check into Hall E – South Building, Metro Toronto Convention Centre (222 Bremner Blvd.) pick up wristbands and timing chips and hand in additional pledges.

Check-in will be open 1 hour prior to climb.

NEW Chip Timing

We are introducing chip timing at this year's event. Your climb will be electronically timed, resulting in faster and more accurate results!

NEW Wristband & Timing Chip Pick-up

Wristbands and timing chips will be distributed at the event. To climb the Tower, you must wear your wristband. Your Team Captain may pick up the wristbands and timing chips when you check in to Hall E. Wristbands and timing chips will not be mailed in advance.

Waivers: Important Information

This package includes the Student Waiver. Please photocopy this waiver, one per participant.

Under 18 years of age? If so, you must be accompanied by at least one adult, 21 years of age or older. Waivers must be signed by a legal guardian prior to the event, and by the climber and adult at the event. **UNACCOMPANIED CLIMBERS UNDER 18 AND THOSE WITHOUT SIGNED WAIVERS AND REGISTRATION FORMS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO CLIMB.**

One signed waiver per participant must be submitted when picking up wristbands and timing chips.

What Happens on the Day of The Climb?

- Wristband pick-up will open at 5:00 am in Hall E - South Building, Metro Toronto Convention Centre, 222 Bremner Blvd.
 - Deposit coats and other personal items in the coat check.*
 - Team Captain will ensure that all waivers are properly filled out. Wristbands and timing chips will not be distributed if the waiver is not submitted.
 - Team Captain will submit all pledge money and waivers at registration area. Only climbers who have submitted the minimum \$30 will receive a wristband and timing chip.
 - You will put your timing chip on your LEFT wrist.
 - The climb takes approximately 30 minutes once entering the Tower.
 - Upon completion, you'll receive a bottle of water.
 - The top can get very busy during the climb. In the interest of public safety, please make your way back to the ground level as soon as possible.
 - Return to the Hall E to receive your official Enbridge CN Tower Climb t-shirt.
- ***Please note:** United Way and CN Tower are not responsible for lost or stolen articles. Please leave all valuables at home.

Terms and Conditions

- NO water bottles, 'camel' packs, backpacks, cameras, phones, MP3 players, IPODs, other portable devices, or infants/children will be allowed in the Tower. Volunteers and/or CN Tower staff will not hold any personal items for climbers.
- Only fanny packs for carrying ID, keys or wallets are permitted. Fanny packs will be inspected.
- Close-toed athletic shoes only. No sandals.
- Hydrating stations will be available prior to climbing and water will be provided to each climber upon completion.
- Backpacks, clothing and other items should be left at home or placed in coat check. United Way volunteers and staff and/or CN Tower staff will not be held responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced items.
- For climbers under 12 years of age, the minimum height restriction is 42 inches/107 cm.
